





The new Oriental Guide Noble David Royal and his team are doing a fantastic job on the bingo and the River Region Shrine Club is now working the grill on the second Tuesday


of the month.

We envision a sit-down session where the interested Nobles could meet with the committee of Past Potentates and dialogue on questions they might have of past leaders.


This would also allow the committee to discuss certain areas of concern they have experienced in their terms on the Divan.



#### GUATEMALA CHILDREN'S ORPHANAGE FIRE REPORT

On March 8th, a horrendous fire tore through an overcrowded orphanage in Guatemala, sadly 40 children perished on the scene from their injuries. Upon being notified of tragedy *Shriners Hospitals for Children immediately enacted a plan to help the survivors*.

Within 24 hours we had two teams on the ground in Guatemala to assess and stabilize survivors meanwhile a US based crisis team assessed how many patients each Shriners Burn Center could handle.

Most survivors were found to suffer from 2nd and 3rd degree burns. You can imagine that these many critical burn patients at one time would overwhelm any medical facility and it was quickly determined that Shriners Hospitals for Children was the ONLY resource capable of handling this many patients at one time.

The fact that this was an orphanage in a foreign country added several levels on complications in providing assistance such as

- No travel documents (Passports & Visas)
- No parents available
- The number of critical care air ambulances required
- Travel approval from both governments

An extra special thank you goes out to our Nobles in Guatemala who after direct discussions with the President of Guatemala were able to have the Guatemala Minister of Health at the hospital and along with the Guatemala passport bureau literally make passports for the patients on the spot.

We received assistance on the next level of complication from former President Jimmy Carter and the Carter Center who worked directly with the U.S. State Department to procure immigration clearance for all patients.

Finally, less than 48 hours from the time of the fire we had patients in the air being flown to our Galveston, Boston, and Northern California Hospitals.

All patients are recovering and one has even been able to return to Guatemala for her wedding, Nobles and Ladies you have a reason to hold your head high as **NO**OTHER medical provider in the **WORLD** could have provided this level of service and thanks to your support these 10 patients will have productive lives.
