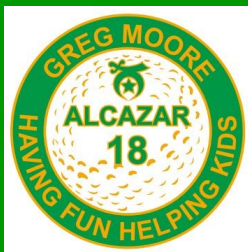

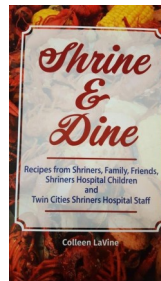

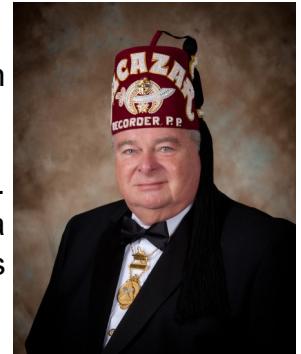


Message from the Recorder

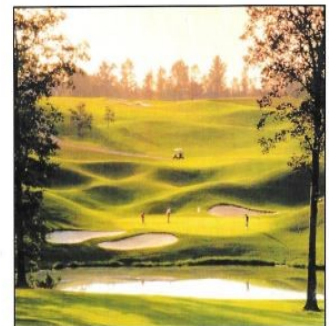
