ALCAZAR SHRINERS GOLF-N-NOBLES



The Alcazar Shriners Golf-N-Nobles Unit may be just the thing for you, if you like to play golf. The Nobles play 13-15 matches annually on some of the best golf course in the surrounding area. We meet at a selected golf course (see tentative 2019 schedule below) once or twice each month at 8:00 am. We set up pairing at 8:30 am and have a short meeting then tee off at 9:00 am for each round. We get a significant discount at each course to include green fee and cart.

We play Stableford (1pt – double bogie; 2pts bogie; 3pts par; 5pts birdie and 8 pts eagle). Additionally, we normally schedule 3-4 two-man scrambles each year. Each player puts in \$5 (individual matches) and \$10 (2-man Scrambles). *Rule #1 for the Golf-N-Noble is to have fun!* 

What could be better, we get discounts on our green fees and carts; we host two "closest to the pin" competitions during each round. If that's not enough we have a Annual Banquet each year, to recognize "The Best Golfer of the Year" and "Most Improved Golfer of the Year" open to members, their families and guests.
