It has been an honor for Lady Ruth and I to serve you this year as the First Lady and Potentate for Alcazar.

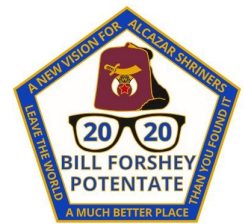

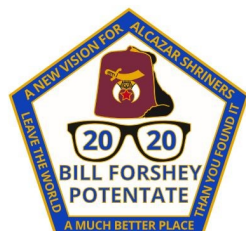
