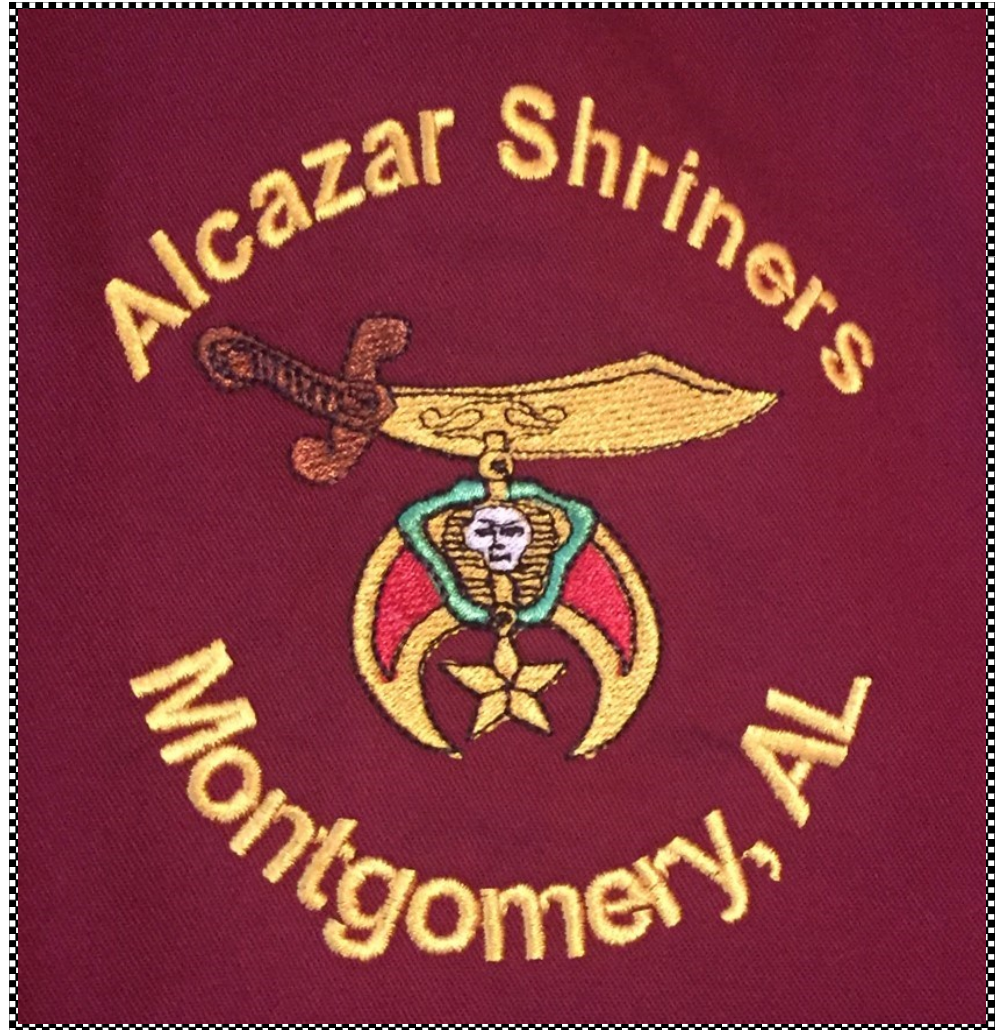

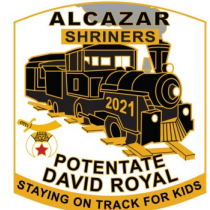
Another event to remember is Date Night at the Red Fez, 12 June 2021. BYOB, RSVP at the temple office.
