

#### Message from the Recorder

Greetings Nobles and Ladies. It is that time again Nobles; time for working our lists of those members that still owe dues for 2023 and 2024 to get them paid before Shriners International rolls the system over in the fall and sends out our 2025 dues notices. Important fact here: technically according to the Imperial Bylaws a Noble is not deficient on a dues year until that year is closed out. That is normally done on 31 December of that year. So, we need to get our dues cleaned up now and not wait until later in the year.



At the writing of this article, we have about 90 Nobles (out of a total count of 560 plus or minus members) that have not paid their 2024 dues. They need to pay those now, so they don't go over the year end and be in a 2-year deficient status which leads to a suspension for non-payment for dues (NPD – Suspended) at the end of 2025. We have sent out an email in late may reminding those members they are

deficient and need to catch up.

There are about 38 members that are in dangerous situations in that they have not paid their 2023 nor their 2024 dues. We have also emailed them as well as calling them in person to get them to catch up on their dues. If these persons do not pay the back dues they will become NPD-Suspended on 1 January 2025 and will no longer be able participate in Shrine Unit/Club activities. This is a serious situation, and we need your help to get these brothers back into order.

Nobles do not have to send in a renewal notice if they are contacted and are in arrears. They can simply send me a check with the 2023 or 2023/2024 payment required or they can call in with a credit card and I can update while they are on the phone. Whatever you need, we can assist, my door is always open.
